The North Shore Soup Kitchen and NOSH are currently in the process of becoming two independent not-for-profit organizations, with each pledging to maintain their deep commitment to serving individuals and families in our community. Read below to learn more...

In the spring of 2020, with the pandemic raging, NOSH was created to provide contactless deliveries to local families in need of food. NOSH was quickly welcomed to become a program of the North Shore Soup Kitchen (NSSK), sharing resources and volunteers and giving NOSH a not-for-profit status that made all donations fully tax deductible. Additionally, drawing on more than 30 years of experience, the North Shore Soup Kitchen was able to provide invaluable technical assistance to the fledgling NOSH.

We are now excited to announce that NOSH, having grown exponentially over the past two years, is ready to become its own not-for-profit organization with plans for future growth in its efforts to meet the needs of our community. Because we share a common mission at NSSK and NOSH – feeding the hungry with dignity and respect – both organizations look forward to continuing to collaborate, helping one another achieve this most important goal for years to come.

As this separation proceeds, here are a few pieces of information you may be curious about:

1. The current North Shore Soup Kitchen Board, representing both NSSK and NOSH, will lead the separation process over the next few months until the legal work is complete and an incorporated NOSH has its own 501c3. At that time, two new Boards of Directors will be created to separately lead each organization going forward.
2. Until this process is complete, when making donations, donors should indicate where gifts should be applied – to NSSK or NOSH or both.
3. Volunteers are encouraged to continue giving back as they have been, with many serving both NOSH and the North Shore Soup Kitchen.
4. Updates on this change process will be posted on our currently shared website and social media sites. Keep an eye on these sites to know when the process is complete.
